One year ago, the wall of a reservoir at an alumina plant near Devecser in northwest Hungary collapsed, unleashing a flood of toxic red sludge that killed several and injured hundreds. Several towns were virtually destroyed. In response, and in coordination with requests from the Government of Hungary, the Hungarian American Coalition established its Red Sludge Disaster Relief Fund.

Thanks to your generosity, patience and open hearts, we are ready to begin disbursing the fund, overseeing a multi-grant process.

The Executive Committee of the Board of Directors of the Hungarian American Coalition has approved five grants to assist the rebuilding efforts in the region.
