

An abstract of Mr. István Dobozi essay in the Hungarian weekly Élet és Irodalom of November 18, 2016:

„Amerika és a világ Donald Trump alatt”

“The United States, the world and Donald Trump”

In sharp contrast with the historic trajectory the Republican Party has become the political home of the society’s least advantaged, the rural population, the white blue collar workers, and the less educated. This gave the appearance of a gradually diminishing voter base, until Trump came along – after a meteoric primary – at the forefront of a grassroots movement reflecting a widespread and deep-seated political and economic dissatisfaction.

Mr. Dobozi concludes his thorough election narrative by pointing out that, with a Trump presidency, the Hungarian prime minister looks forward to an improvement in Hungarian-American relations.
